

2-DAY FOUNDATIONAL WORKSHOP

Structured Professional Judgement: Teams, Tools, and the Death of ipse dixit

Facilitated by J. Reid Meloy, PhD and Molly Amman, JD, CTM



The 2-day workshop held October 25 & 26 at the outset of the annual event will build on the foundational use of structured professional judgement (SPJ) instruments for behavioural threat assessment and management (BTAM). Emphasis throughout will be placed upon their use as integrated, time-sensitive maps to help guide information gathering and decisions that are made over time by the entire multidisciplinary BTAM team.

Two SPJ instruments will be introduced during day one to provide the structure for this training, the Workplace Assessment of Violence Risk (WAVR-21) and the Terrorist Radicalization Assessment Protocol (TRAP-18), both developed by Dr. Meloy and colleagues. The second day of the workshop will involve the application of these structured professional judgement instruments to well known cases of grievance-fueled targeted violence in the workplace, and ideologically motivated targeted violence in the community. Methods of teaching will include didactics, large group discussion, video interviews of such perpetrators, and the gaming of a real time practice scenario.
